#### **Speaker bio**

This should be no longer than 150 words, and give a brief description of your background and relevant skills and experiences. Your bio will be published on the conference website in the lead up to VAC 2012.

#### **Abstract**

Abstracts should not exceed 300 words and should highlight the practical strategies you will be presenting on. Your abstract must also specify your intended audience (early childhood, primary age, adolescents or adults). Please be aware that your abstract will appear online and in the conference program, so please take care to ensure that the abstract is of a standard that is acceptable for publication. Please note that we reserve the right to edit (or ask you to edit) your abstract should we consider it necessary.

#### **Upload a photo**

Successful applicants will need to submit a photo to be published on the Autism Victoria website (and possibly the conference program) along with your biography in promotion of the conference. Please provide a clear photograph of your face against a plain background for best results.
