Update and Information Sessions

Work continues at Autism Victoria to get Autism Accreditation ready for implementation

A standards working party has been established to assist in the development of Early Intervention specialist standards. The party members have a variety of expertise ranging from academics and researchers in the field, specific professional body professionals and field professionals in the area of EI who have an extensive knowledge of Autism and Early Intervention. The working party has 8-10 members and includes international member professionals from NAS to help give support and advice along the process.

The accreditation standards that will be implemented initially are:

- Early Intervention specialist standards, for organisations offering Early Intervention services to children with ASD, exclusively or not exclusively.
- Early Intervention specialist standards for Individual Therapists (self employed

business) working with children with an ASD.

- Core ASD standards are mandatory for all services and individuals registered with Accreditation to demonstrate their ASD specific knowledge and expertise. The mandatory core have been developed by an internationally recognised standards body that have identified these standards as being key elements of knowledge and practice that any service or individual working with a person with ASD should be aware of across the lifespan of individuals with ASD.
