

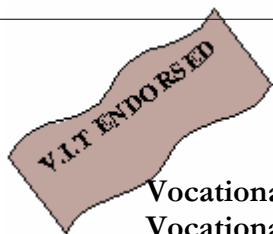

Vocational Graduate Diploma of Teaching Students with ASD (21688VIC)



As the diagnosis of ASD increases, so too does the need for teachers with specialist training in this area. The Autism Teaching Institute has developed competency based training courses to provide these specialist skills.

Completion of the Vocational Graduate Diploma by qualified teachers is recognized by the VIT as a Special Ed. qualification or as conferring 3 year trained teachers 4 year trained status.

Priority is given to those applicants who work directly with students with an ASD in either a special or mainstream school/setting.
