KEYNOTE SPEAKER - Dr Susan Leekam

Sue Leekam is a Reader in Developmental Psychology at the University of Durham, UK. Her research in autism reflects a particular interest in the developmental changes that occur in behaviour and cognition. She is also investigating the occurrence of features of autism in typical infant development in a major longitudinal research study of infants. She was involved in developing and publishing the Diagnostic Interview of Social and Communication Disorders (DISCO), and has set up a specialist unit for research and postgraduate training in developmental psychopathology. Sue's presentation will focus on Social Attention and Social-Cognitive Development in Autism.
