Outline of Research	Our study is looking at the attention profiles in children with different developmental disabilities. To be eligible children must be: * 5 - 12 years old * attending school * have a FSIQ < 70 Please note that children do not need to have attention difficulties or a diagnosis of ADHD. We are looking at profiles of attention (i.e., strengths and weaknesses) in the areas of hyperactivity, impulsivity, inattention and working memory, so we need to recruit children across the spectrum from good attention skills to very poor attention skills. This study will involve the parents completing a short rating scale (takes about 10 minutes to complete) and their child's teacher completing some rating scales. It may also involve the child receiving an IQ assessment at their school if they have not had one in the last 2 years.
